It is to note that, due to the acute space constraints in the existing university campus and considering the availability of basic infrastructure to start the campus at the newly allotted site, the university is proposing for immediate shifting of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences to the proposed extension centre/campus at Kamki under Kamba Circle, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh.

In view of the above, the university has written a letter to Ministry of Education for granting necessary permission/approval to start the extension campus/centre at Kamki under Kamba Circle, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh at the earliest.

Decisions: The Academic Council noted the development with appreciation and commended the university for its proactive steps toward academic expansion and infrastructural decongestion. The Council also placed on record its gratitude to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh for providing land free of cost to enable the university to expand its campus for higher education institution. In this regard, it was resolved that the University shall issue a formal letter of appreciation to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh for its continued support towards the University's noble cause of educational development.
