Nursing Council, New Delhi. The last date for admission has been fixed as 31st Dec., 2022. Since, the first batch of students were admitted before 31st October, 2022 and have completed their course papers, they are ready to appear in semester exams scheduled in December, 2022. The second batch would of course appear after completion of their courses in due course of time. In this context, the University was requested to decide whether both the batches should appear in one examination or there should be separate examinations.

The AC after a threadbare discussion decided that, the University shall follow its academic calendar and examination of the second batch if any would be held later on. The two batches may be merged into one in second or third semester. This shall be applicable to the all the affiliated nursing colleges.

3. To grant Temporary affiliation to Galaxy Science College, Nirjuli, Arunachal Pradesh.

The AC noted that the Managing Director of the proposed new college, namely Galaxy Science College, Nirjuli, Arunachal Pradesh, has submitted an application for the grant of Temporary affiliation to start a Science College offering B.Sc. programme. Accordingly, a 3 member Inspection Committee for Physical Inspection under the chairmanship of Prof. T. Lungdim, Dean, FE was constituted. The team visited the college on 17th August, 2022, and carried out the inspection towards the grant of Temporary Affiliation to the College and the committee submitted its report with negative remarks. The report of the visit to the Galaxy Science College was presented before the members of AC by the Chairman of the inspection committee and the Director, CDC in detail.

The Academic Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor to revisit the case and to re-put up in the next AC meeting with all the details for perusal and decision.

As there was no other item for discussion, the 42nd Meeting of the Academic Council ended with proposal of Vote of Thanks from the Joint Registrar, Dr. David Pertin to the Chair.


